- Support writing funding applications, implementing projects' activities, reporting;
- Support organising YES Forum's events, conferences and trainings;

Your profile:

- Minimum 3 years of relevant work experience in advocacy in the field of youth or social affairs
- A degree in at least in one of the following areas: Educational Sciences, Political / Social Sciences, European Studies, or related fields
- Knowledge of the EU institutions and policy-making processes
- Strong (English) communication and public speaking presentation, facilitation, and networking skills to negotiate and maintain relationships with relevant and diverse stakeholders
- Excellent spoken and written English, German and other European languages are an asset;
- Excellent writing and editing skills

We offer:

- To actively working to achieve positive change for young people
- Full FTE up to 4.500 € gross monthly salary, depending on experience, 32h / week
- Fixed-term contract until 31 December 2024; with possibility of extension
- 30 days annual leave (plus bank holidays)
- A working place in Stuttgart, Germany and regular business travel throughout Europe
